- 1.2. ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE OFFICIAL FORMS PROVIDED—(NOT TO BE RE-TYPED) OR IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED IN THE BID DOCUMENT.
- 1.3. TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Development Bank of Southern Africa was created to catalyze economic growth through investment in economic and social infrastructure and supporting regional integration. Its strategic objectives are to drive sustainable growth in development impact; integrated infrastructure solutions and financial sustainability. The Bank has to unlock infrastructure to the value of R100bn per annum by 2020/2021 as per the Corporate Plan. Against this background, it is imperative to accelerate the development of competencies that will give the institution a competitive advantage both in current and future markets.

Purpose

As part of the DBSA compliance with the new legislation that all buildings will display an energy certificate, the DBSA is going out on tender for a suitable service provider. The service provider will be required to assess the energy consumption of the DBSA buildings whilst making recommendations for greater energy savings.

Request for Proposal

In order to comply with the Regulations for the Mandatory Display and Submission of Energy Performance Certificates for Buildings, the Development Bank of Southern Africa (DBSA) is hereby inviting suitably qualified and experienced service providers to submit priced proposals to assess and determine the energy performance of their campus in Midrand and issue the appropriate energy performance certificate.

The energy performance assessment shall be conducted in accordance with the **SANS 1544:2014**. According to the standard, the energy performance of the building shall be expressed in terms of the net energy consumed in kilowatt hours per square metre per year (kWh/m²/a) to meet the different needs associated with the use of the building excluding measured or assessed energy consumed by car parks and storage areas as well as energy consumed by outdoor services such as landscape and security lighting, etc.

The net energy consumption shall include the amount of all energy carriers, and shall be assessed as accurately as reasonably practical, from recorded data, energy bills or measurements.

The building energy performance is graded from **A** to **G**, with A being the most energy efficient and G the least efficient. Buildings are expected to achieve at least a D-rating in order to be compliant with the national building regulations and must clearly display their EPC at the building entrance of the facility.

The tenderer to be appointed will carry out the following tasks:

1. Conduct a site inspection of the DBSA campus.
2. Data collection on the building location, activity, and energy consumption.

3. Assess the collected data and determine an energy performance rating in accordance with the standard and building classifications
4. Submit to SANEDI an electronic copy of all specified data used to determine the EPC-rating to populate the National EPC Building Register and issue a unique EPC Certificate number.
5. Based on the above assessment and rating, the service provider will issue an Energy Performance Certificate to DBSA.

The regulation requires that an Accounting Officer of DBSA submits an electronic copy of the EPC certificate to SANEDI.

Qualification of tenderer

The tenderer must be an accredited Inspection Body (IB) for Energy Performance Certificates for Buildings as accredited by the South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) or by a member of the recognition arrangements of the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation or the International Accreditation Forum, as is required by the Regulations for The Mandatory Display And Submission of Energy Performance Certificates for Buildings and in accordance with SANS 1544: 2014 Energy Certificates for Buildings. The Accreditation Certificate to be provided with tender at time of submission.

Experience of team members

A CV is to be provided for each key project team member indicating the number of years of relevant work experience in Building Energy Performance Certificates, Building Energy Audits and/or Building Energy Management & Verification Services, all relevant qualifications and training, and a sample project relevant to this experience and their role. It is possible for one person to perform more than one of the three key roles of technical manager, quality manager and inspector/energy performance assessor.

Past projects of the company

A table of past projects of a similar nature from within the last 10 years, such as Energy Performance Certificates, Energy Building Audits or Energy Measurement and Verification, including for each project the start and end date, the location, the name and contact details of the client, a short description of the work undertaken and the rand value of the project.
